**STUDY SESSION**

1. Waste Connections – Recycle program

Current ten (10) year contract with Waste Connections expires in 2011 with the possibility of two (2) five (5) year extensions

Currently the residents use the three (3) bin recycle system

Ability to move into the "Big Blue" commingle cart system with glass separated from remaining recyclable items

Costs to remain approximately the same

Council direction: Staff to bring forward a contract including the cart system recycle program with Waste Connections for council review

2. E-Verify program

Federal contractors and sub-contractors are required to use the E-Verify system when awarded a federal contract but it is a voluntary program for non-federal contractors

Allows for verification of employees assigned to the federal contract and new hires


Non-federal contractors may only verify new hires


Program is used to verify social security numbers of employees

Clark County will now require all contractors awarded contracts in excess of \$1,000,000 to comply with the E-Verify program

Council direction: City Manager to brief Mayor Onslow and Council member Taylor on program
