City of Ridgefield Council

The Ridgefield City Council is made of up five community members who are elected to their positions by the citizens of Ridgefield and serve as the community leaders and policy makers. Council meetings are held at 6:30 p.m. at the Ridgefield Community Center (210 N. Main) on the 2nd and 4th Thursdays of each month, with the exception of November and December when meetings are held and the 1st and 3rd Thursday. City of Ridgefield Planning Commission

The Planning Commission is an advisory body of seven volunteer citizens who advise the City Council on planning, development and growth issues for the community. Planning Commission meetings are held at 6:30 p.m. at the Ridgefield Community Center (210 N. Main) on the 1st Wednesday of each month.

City of Ridgefield Parks Advisory Board

The Parks Advisory Board is an advisory body of seven volunteer citizens who advise the City Council on parks planning, parks acquisition, and parks operations and maintenance within the current and future city limits of the City of Ridgefield. Parks Advisory Board meetings are held at 7:00 p.m. at the Ridgefield Community Center (210 N. Main) on the 2nd Tuesday of each month.

City of Ridgefield Civil Service Commission

The Ridgefield Civil Service Commission is an advisory body of three volunteer citizens who preside over the civil service system for the Ridgefield Police Department. Civil Service Commission meetings are held at 7:00 p.m. at Ridgefield City Hall (230 Pioneer Street) on the 2nd Tuesday of each month.

City of Ridgefield Cemetery Advisory Board

The Ridgefield Cemetery Advisory Board is an advisory body of three volunteer citizens who advise City Council on operation and maintenance of the City-owned cemetery. Cemetery Board meetings times and locations vary; for more information contact City Hall at (360) 887-3557.

Port of Ridgefield Commission
