

RESOLUTION NO. 387

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF RIDGEFIELD, WASHINGTON
ADOPTING AN AMENDMENT TO THE COMPREHENSIVE SIX-YEAR
TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR 2011-2016**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Revised Code of Washington (RCW) Section 35.77.010, City staff have prepared a revised and extended Comprehensive Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program for 2011-2016; and,

WHEREAS, the purpose of said revised and extended program is to ensure that the City of Ridgefield will have available advance plans for use as a guide in carrying out a coordinated street construction program; and,

WHEREAS, the 2011-2016 Comprehensive Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program was adopted by the Ridgefield City Council on June 10, 2010 via Resolution Number 383; and,


WHEREAS, the originally adopted 2011-2016 Comprehensive Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program requires an amendment to include the SR 501 Ridgefield Welcome Center project along with appropriate funding to allow for obligation of federal grant monies for the project; and


WHEREAS, notice of the time and place for a hearing of said plan was published in accordance with laws requiring setting time and place for a hearing thereon at the Ridgefield Community Center, 210 N. Main Avenue, Ridgefield, Washington on September 9, 2010, at a regular City Council meeting. At such time and place, City Council held a public hearing and considered said Comprehensive Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program amendment for 2011-2016,

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIDGEFIELD, WASHINGTON DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City of Ridgefield amended Comprehensive Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program for 2011-2016 attached hereto as Exhibit "1" is adopted as the current transportation improvement program for the City of Ridgefield. The Public Works Director is hereby directed to forthwith file the amended Comprehensive Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program for 2011-2016 with the Washington State Department of Transportation.
2. This resolution shall be in full force and effect on September 10, 2010.
